## TRAINING FEES

### PER HORSE

#### Per Day Rates

- Full Training \$125
- Layups \$60
- Yearlings \$55
- Post Surgery Care \$85
- Breaking \$90
- 2-Year-Old Pre-Training \$110
- Broodmares \$45 (Foals \$10)
- Weanlings \$25
- **12% of all purse earnings**
- **Two (2) Lifetime Breeding Rights for Colts\***
- **5% commission of selling price** if horse is sold
- **Stall Rent:** equal to stable charges
- **Blacksmith:** equal to blacksmith's charge
- **Dentist:** equal to dentist's charge
- **Vanning:** comparable to quality carriers fees
- **Supplements, Wormers, and Medications:** charges dependent on market prices and specific handling/administration of product

## COMMISSION RATES

### PER HORSE

#### Auction

- Purchasing a Horse That Sells For:
  - \$25,000 or Less: 10% of purchase price
  - Over \$25,000: 5% of purchase price
- Selling Horse: 5% of selling price
- Two (2) Lifetime Breeding Rights for Colts\*

#### Private Purchases

- Purchasing: 5% of purchase price
- Selling: 5% of selling price
- Two (2) Lifetime Breeding Rights for Colts\*

#### Foreign Purchases

- Purchasing: 10% of purchase price
- Selling: 5% of selling price
- Two (2) Lifetime Breeding Rights for Colts\*

#### Miscellaneous

- Shipping Expenses include hotel, airfare, and rental vehicle
